In order for the sale of your *chametz* to be effective, all foods that are forbidden during Passover should be placed in a separate room or locked cabinet for the duration of the holiday. Donations that accompany this form will be forwarded to a local Birmingham charity.

It is also customary to provide funds for Jews who can’t afford *matzah* for seder. If you would like to help those in need, please write a check to the Rabbi’s *Matzah* Fund.
