Individualized Bar/Bat Mitzvah Training—(Required) Training begins approximately 9 months prior to the B’nai Mitzvah date at TBE. \$800 fee covers individualized training and support by the TBE staff as you plan your simcha. Full payment due by beginning of B’nai Mitzvah Training, including tutoring, staff assistance for simcha planning, and Rabbinic support.

Confirmation Fee—(Required - Grade 10 only) Contributes to community celebration, gifts, and Confirmation program. (Does not include expenses for Confirmation trip.)

Youth Groups—(Optional but strongly encouraged) Students may participate in Youth Group meetings/activities for Chaverim (Grades 3-5) Kadima (6-8) or USY (9-12). Most activities are planned for Sundays directly following Religious School. A detailed Youth Group calendar is coming soon! **Additional Youth Group activity fees will be charged per event when needed.**

This is a Community Involvement Award. Students are asked to log volunteer hours in the community. Zivitz Camp Ramah Merit Award:

Attendance at Camp Ramah (the Conservative Movement's summer sleep-away program) is highly encouraged. Students interested in attending camp may apply for a Zivitz Camp Ramah merit-based award. Candidates may apply for up to \$500 for a new or returning camper. Interested candidates should submit for review examples of contributions they have made to the Temple Beth-El community. Such examples could include but are not limited to:

- Shabbat/Holiday Service Leading
- Regular Attendance at Youth Programming
- Regular Attendance at Religious School Classes/Functions
- Social Action Involvement through TBE Affiliates
